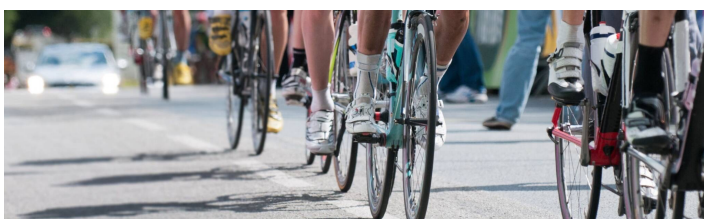
Committee Matters
